Consent

- If approved by my high school counselor to enroll in the Jayhawk Blueprint program, I will be enrolled as a non-degree seeking student at the University of Kansas.
- Courses will be more academically challenging than traditional high school courses. The grade(s) received for the concurrent enrollment courses will become a permanent part of my University of Kansas transcript.
- It is my responsibility to ensure the courses taken are transferable to the college/university that I will be attending after high school graduation.
- I am responsible for transcript requests. The request form is available here: <https://registrar.ku.edu/order-transcript>.
- It is my responsibility to withdraw from courses online. Failure to drop/withdraw from a University of Kansas course following established deadlines, policies, and procedures may result in a failing grade for the course.
- The high school and the University of Kansas may share copies of information regarding official academic records.
- Once enrolled in the program, I will be considered a University of Kansas student and all University of Kansas policies (<http://www.policy.ku.edu/>) affecting students will apply.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Any financial obligations are payable to the high school by the student and/or the parent/legal guardian if the student is minor.

AGREEMENT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

My Responsibility

I acknowledge that enrollment for courses at the University of Kansas constitutes a financial obligation. I understand and agree that I have financial responsibility for the payment of all tuition, fees, and other University of Kansas (“KU” or “University”) charges on the student high school account relating to the student’s enrollment and/or attendance at KU. I understand that, regardless of any expected reliance on any third-party resources, including but not limited to financial aid, family resources, employer reimbursement, government assistance or any other external resources, I remain personally and solely responsible for paying any and all outstanding balances.

Student Age

I understand and agree that if I am under age 18 when I sign this Agreement that the educational services provided by The University of Kansas are a necessity, and I am contractually obligated to pay under the “doctrine of necessities” under Kansas state law.

Bills

After the student enrolls in the high school, I understand that the fee will be attached to the high school course enrollment. I agree that I am responsible for the required course fee payment and will pay any and all charges by the due date to the high school. Information regarding the current published tuition and fees schedules are available at <http://registrar.ku.edu/tuition-and-fees>. Tuition and fees charges are subject to change every semester.

Third-Party Sponsors or Financial Aid

I understand that if the student's financial aid or sponsorship is reduced or cancelled for any reason, I remain responsible for any outstanding balance. I also agree that KU may discuss the student's account with any third party sponsors.

Payment Due Date

Payment for all outstanding charges is due by the deadline established by the high schools.

Tuition Adjustment:

In the event the student drops hours or totally withdraws from KU, I understand it may result in charges owed based on the classes dropped and dates of the drop or withdrawal. Information on dropping or withdrawing can be found online at <http://blueprint.ku.edu/withdrawdrop>. I understand if the student withdraws from a term or drop classes after a class begins, I will be responsible for all or a percentage of the tuition charged by the USD497 high school for this course fee. The adjustments of tuition will be made in accordance with KU's academic calendar (<http://registrar.ku.edu/calendar>) for classes that meet the full term. I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure the student completes the Withdraw Form within the appropriate deadlines for any semester to avoid financial obligation.

Billing Disputes

I understand that if I believe a charge on the student's bill is incorrect, it is my responsibility to contact the bookkeeper at the respective high school that has assessed the charge.

Collection Activity on Past Due Accounts

I understand that if the student's account remains unpaid at final due date by the high school and becomes delinquent, the high school will transfer the delinquent account to a collection agency/third party servicer/Kansas State Setoff and/or report any delinquency to credit bureau(s).

Electronic Business and Communication

I agree to conduct business, including but not limited to signing this Agreement and incurring financial obligations, with the high school electronically. I authorize the high school, KU and its agents, representatives, attorneys, and contractors (including collection agencies) to contact me at the current or any future mobile phone number, home phone number and email address I provide to KU, including by way of automated telephone dialing equipment, or artificial or prerecorded voice or text messages, for purposes of business, including collecting any portion of the student's financial obligation which is due or past due.

KU Policy

I acknowledge and agree that this Agreement does not alter my obligations under the policies of the University of Kansas, which are set forth at www.policy.ku.edu, and that this Agreement should be read in concert with such policies.
