### **What is Jayhawk Blueprint?**

Jayhawk Blueprint is a partnership between the University of Kansas and Lawrence Public Schools that allows high school juniors and seniors to take KU courses at a reduced cost within their own high school and earn up to 22 college credit hours before graduation. Credits transfer to all public 2- and 4-year colleges in Kansas and fulfill both Systemwide General Education and KU Core 34 requirements.

### **What courses are currently available?**

- BIOL 100/102: Principles of Biology & Lab
- COMS 130: Public Speaking
- ENGL 101: Composition
- ENGL 102: Critical Reading and Writing
- HIST 128: History of the US Through the Civil War
- HIST 129: History of the US After the Civil War
- MATH 101: College Algebra

### **How much does it cost to take a Blueprint course?**

Jayhawk Blueprint courses are offered at a significantly reduced rate. For the 2026-2027 school year, tuition is expected to be \$113 per credit hour—70% less than standard in-state tuition at KU. Textbooks and course materials are included at no additional cost. Tuition assistance is also available for students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals.

### **How do students enroll in a Blueprint course?**

Students will work with their high school counselor to confirm eligibility and enroll during their school's regular enrollment period. At the start of each semester, students must also complete either a KU application or the Jayhawk Blueprint enrollment form. Additional details and guidance will be provided by Blueprint staff.
